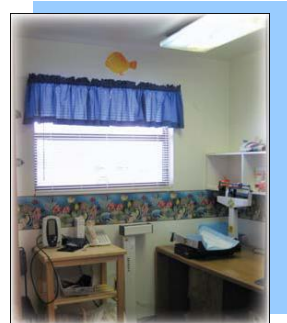

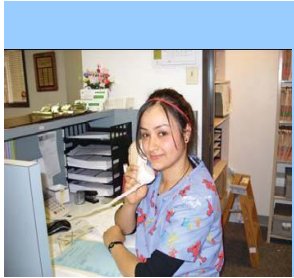

CHS Mission

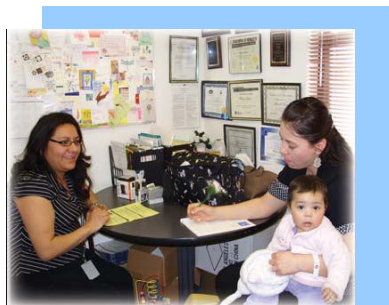
Community Health Services (CHS) is committed to improving the health and well-being of infants, children and youth through providing primary and preventative health services in partnership with schools and other community organizations.

CHS is a private, non-profit organization created specifically to meet the needs of children ages birth to 21. CHS is governed by a volunteer board of community members.

Health care is provided year-round at our Commerce City, Baker and Kearney clinics.

Service Area

CHS does NOT have service area boundaries. All children and adolescents welcome!

Primary Health Care Services

CHS offers primary care for children ages birth to 21. Services include the following:

- ✓ Annual Physicals
- ✓ Well Child Checks
- ✓ Immunizations
- ✓ Sick Child Visits
- ✓ Sports and Camp Physicals
- ✓ Adolescent Health Services
- ✓ Treatment of acute minor illness and referrals
- ✓ Plus Much More

Special Services

✓ Immunization Clinic

CHS offers a walk-in immunization clinic once a week.

- Children ages 4-18 with NO health insurance or on Regular Medicaid.
- Cost is \$10 each immunization, due at the time of service. (Not refused for inability to pay)
- Child's immunization record is required.

✓ Community Outreach Program

CHS is a child Presumptive Eligibility site (PE) **temporary coverage** for Medicaid and CHP+ .

- Provides information on government health insurance programs (Medicaid and CHP+).
- Assists families in filling out the Medicaid/CHP+ application.
- Assists families in navigating through the Medicaid and CHP+ system.
- Financially screens for the CHS sliding fee scale.
- Please call for an appointment.

Special Services (continued)

✓ The Keep Me Safe Program

CHS provides Child Passenger Safety services by providing education to families on how to properly install and utilize car seats.

- Provides a complete check up of your child 's car seat
- A certified child passenger technician will review your child's seat for the following:
 - over-all safety
 - recalls
 - correct installation
 - proper fit of your child in the seat

✓ Dental Van

CHS partners with Rocky Mountain Youth to provide dental services. The dental mobile unit arrives once a month at CHS locations to provide dental services to uninsured children ages 3-17.

✓ School-Nursing Program

School Nurses coordinate the health, social and emotional needs of students. They supervise medical emergencies and crisis interventions while promoting health education and safety standards for students and staff in Adams County School Districts 14 and 50.

CHS offers professional counseling to children and adolescents in both the school and clinic setting. Consultation information and referral services are also offered.
